

IDS-2 NormViewer

Instructions for viewing the IDS-2 standardisation tables in the Hogrefe Testsystem



Step 1: Click on the test catalogue (1) near the top right of the screen. After a few seconds, a list of all tests published on Hogrefe Testsystem appears.

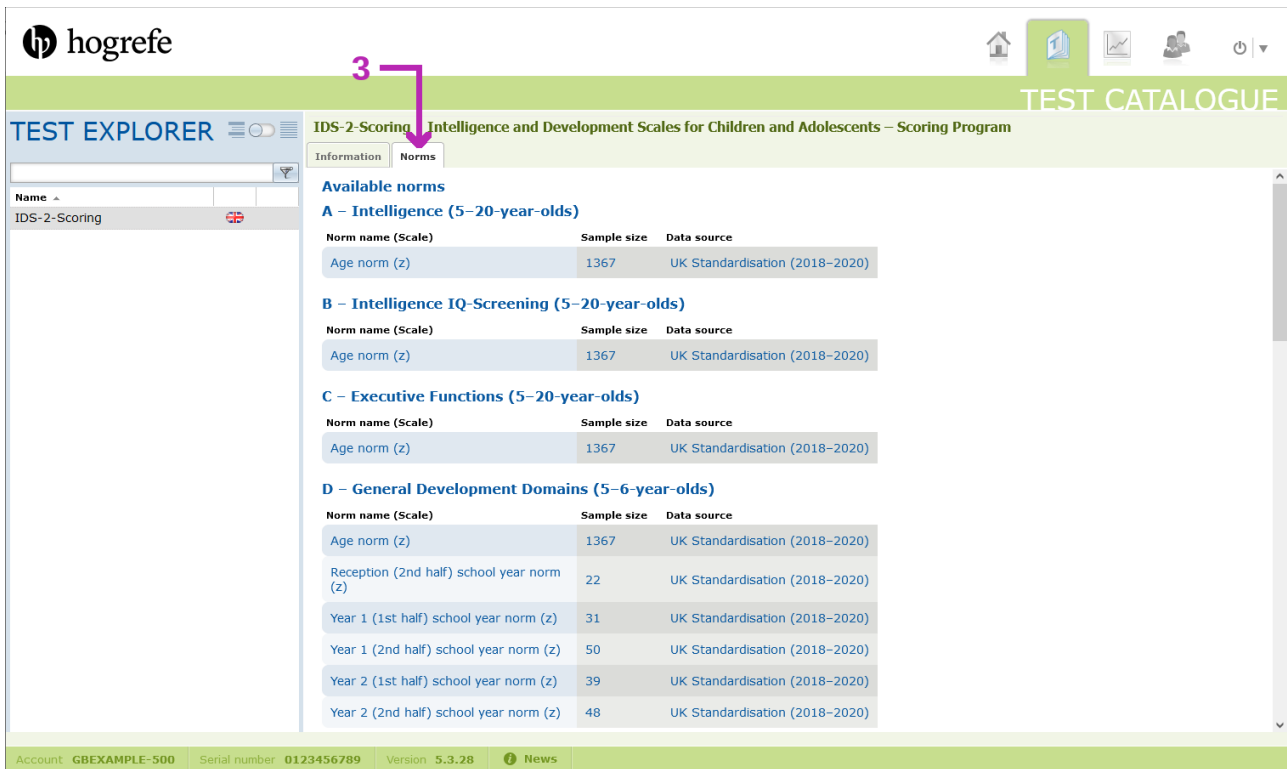
Step 2: To see only the tests in your account, move the 'TEST EXPLORER' slider to the left. Then click on 'IDS-2-Scoring'. This displays general information about the test:

A 'Structure' table is also present, listing various subtests and their corresponding subtest ranges.

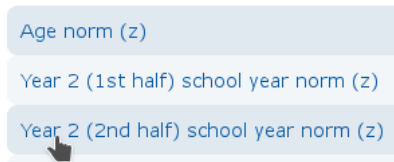

Step 3: Switch to the tab marked 'Norms'. Age norms are available for every record form, and appropriate school half-year norms for the Scholastic Skills section of D, E, and F.



Step 4: Click on 'Age norm (z)' or one of the school half-year norms. A new tab opens for each chosen norm. You can open several tabs and switch back and forth.



- Step 5: If using age norms, choose an age in years and months. For example, '7;5-7;5' selects the norm table for children aged 7 years and 5 months.
- Step 6: Choose from the available dimensions, for example, 'Receptive language' or 'Reading speed – passage 1'.
- Step 7: Finally, choose the appropriate scale. This is usually 'SS (1-19)' or 'WP', which shows the standard scores from 1 to 19. For the intelligence factors and the IQ-Screening, IQ, and IQ-Profile scores, choose scale 'IQ' to convert Σ SS into scores on the IQ scale.
